The submission must be anonymous, with no author names, affiliations, acknowledgements, or obvious references. The paper should be prepared according to the "Authors Instruction for LNCS" (<http://www.springer.de/comp/lncs/authors.html>) and limited to at most 15 pages in total. Papers must be submitted electronically. Authors of accepted papers must give oral presentation at the workshop. The author of the published paper of JWIS2006 workshop are allowed to submit it to other international conference or domestic conference.
